



## **Prospective Student-Athlete**

### **Complimentary Admissions Policy**

#### Official Visit

A prospective student-athlete can receive a maximum of three complimentary admissions for the exclusive use of the PSA and those accompanying him/her on the visit (NCAA Bylaws 13.7.5.2 & 13.8.2.1). In addition, per NCAA Bylaw 13.7.5.2.3, an institution may reserve additional tickets during an official visit only for the use of a perspective student-athlete's immediate family members at seat locations adjacent to the complimentary seats and they must be purchased at face value.

#### Unofficial Visit

In accordance with NCAA Bylaw 13.8.2.1, during an unofficial visit, George Mason may not pay any expenses or provide entertainment except a maximum of three complimentary admissions to a campus athletic event in which the institution's athletic team competes. In addition, an institution may not reserve tickets (in addition to the permissible complimentary admissions) to be purchased by a prospect on an unofficial visit. Tickets may be purchased only in the same manner as any other member of the public (NCAA Bylaw 13.8.2.1.4).

Complimentary Admissions Forms for both Official and Unofficial Visits must be submitted to the Compliance Office not later than 5:00 p.m. prior to the date of the contest that tickets are being requested for. The Compliance Office will submit forms to the Athletic Ticket Office.
