noon the day after the game

Evaluation Period: High school,

ship competition that does not

Telephone Calls to Perspective Student-Athletes (Bylaw 13.1.3)

Time Period for Telephone Calls (Bylaw 13.1.3.1)

Telephone calls to a prospective student-athlete [or the prospective student-athlete's relatives or legal guardian(s)] may not be made before **July 1** following the completion of the prospective student-athlete's **junior year** in high school (subject to the exceptions below); thereafter, staff members shall not make such telephone calls more than once per week.

Exception -- Men's Basketball (Bylaw 13.1.3.1.2)

In men's basketball, an institution is permitted to make one telephone call per month to a prospective student-athlete (or the prospective student-athlete's relatives or legal guardians) on or after June 15 of the prospective student-athlete's sophomore year in high school through July 31 of the prospective student-athlete's junior year in high school. An institution is permitted to make two telephone calls per week to a prospective student-athlete (or the prospective student-athlete's relatives or legal guardians) beginning August 1 prior to the prospective student-athlete's senior year in high school. An institution is permitted to make one telephone call per week to a two-year or four-year college prospective student-athlete (or the prospective student-athlete's relatives or legal guardians).

Exception -- Women's Basketball (Bylaw 13.1.3.1.3)

In women's basketball, telephone calls may be made to a prospective student-athlete (or the prospective student-athlete's relatives or legal guardians) as follows:

- (a) One telephone call during the month of April of the prospective student-athlete's junior year in high school on or after the Thursday after the conclusion of the NCAA Division I Women's Final Four.
- (b) One telephone call during the month of May of the prospective student-athlete's junior year in high school.
- (c) One telephone call on or after June 1 through June 20 of the prospective student-athlete's junior year in high school.
- (d) One telephone call on or after June 21 through June 30 of the prospective student-athlete's junior year in high school
- (e) Three telephone calls during the month of July following the prospective student-athlete's junior year in high school, with no more than one telephone call per week
- (f) Thereafter, one telephone call per week.

Baseball

Contact Period: March 1st– August 31st, except for:

Dead Period: Monday– Thursday of the week that includes the initial date for the Spring signing of the National Letter of Intent

Women's Lacrosse

Contact Period: Monday after the championship through July 31st

Cross Country/Track and Field

Contact Period: January 3rd– July 31st, except for:

Dead Period: 12:01 am on the 1st day of the NCAA DI Men's and Women's Indoor Track and Field Championship to 12:01 am on the day following the completion of the championships, Monday– Thursday of the week that includes the initial date for the Spring signing of the National Letter of Intent, 12:01 am on the 1st day of the NCAA DI Men's and Women's Outdoor Track and Field Championship to 12:01 am on the day following the completion of the championships

Women's Volleyball

Contact Period: January 1st– July 31st, except for:

Quiet Period: May 1st to the Friday prior to Memorial Day

Other Sports

Dead Period: Monday– Thursday of the week that includes the initial date for the Spring signing of the National Letter of Intent in the applicable sport

Telephone Calls to Perspective Student-Athletes continued:

Additional Restrictions -- July Evaluation Periods (Bylaw 13.1.3.1.3.2)

In women's basketball, during the July evaluation periods, all communication with a prospective student-athlete, the prospective student-athlete's relatives or legal guardians, the prospective student-athlete's coach or any individual associated with the prospective student-athlete as a result of the prospective student-athlete's participation in basketball, directly or indirectly, is prohibited.



Contacts-July Evaluation Periods

Women's Basketball (Bylaw 13.1.6.4.2)

In women's basketball, during the July evaluation periods, all communication with a prospective student-athlete, the prospective student-athlete's relatives or legal guardians, the prospective student-athlete's coach or any individual associated with the prospective student-athlete as a result of the prospective student-athlete's participation in basketball, directly or indirectly, is prohibited (It is permissible for an institution to have contact with a prospective student-athlete who is enrolled in the institution's summer term (summer session or summer bridge program) and has signed a National Letter of Intent or other written commitment to attend the institution.).

Basketball Evaluations-Summer Evaluation Period

(Bylaw 13.1.8.8)

During the summer evaluation period, a member of an institution's basketball coaching staff may attend institutional basketball camps per Bylaw 13.12.1.1; and non-institutional organized events (e.g., camps, leagues, tournaments and festivals) that are certified per Bylaw 30.15.

Official/ Unofficial Visits– July Evaluation Period

Women's Basketball

In women's basketball, an institution may **not** provide an **expense-paid** visit to a prospective student-athlete during the July evaluation periods (**Bylaw 13.6.2.2.2**)

In women's basketball, a prospective student-athlete may **not** make **unofficial visits** during the July evaluation periods (**Bylaw 13.7.1.2**)

Men's Basketball

In men's basketball, a prospective student-athlete may **not** make **unofficial visits** during the month of July (**Bylaw 13.7.1.1**)
