New Legislation –

- (1) Permissible Meals - Nutritional Supplements and Fruits, Nuts and Bagels (Bylaw 16.5.2 g & h)
- (2) Grad Data, APR, GSR, Banned Drug List and Initial Eligibility Standards will be forwarded to the prospects once they are placed on our IRL
- (3) Electronic Transmissions after Receipt of Room or Tuition Deposit, On or After May 1 of Prospect's Senior Year after offer of Admission
- (4) Two Year College Transfer – Six Semester Hours of English and 3 Semester Hours of Math (Bylaw 14.5.4.2)
- (5) Official Visit – Non-Traditional Family Members (divorce, separation) can be provided an additional two complimentary tickets to athletic events on campus (Bylaw 13.6.7.2.1)
- (6) Initial Eligibility Standards – Students with Disabilities three core classes after graduation (Bylaw 14.3.1.2.1.2)
